#### **Media List**

- •Flotilla and Division Staff officers should maintain a "Media List" containing contact information to local media outlets. This should be shared up and down the chain of communication.
- •The SPO-NSBW will create a master list and provide it to the PA leadership team.

#### **Press Releases**

The DSO-PA will provide the SO-PA/FSO-PA's pre-written news releases that can be sent to all local print media outlets





#### **Electronic Media**

#### **Television**

- Cable/Community TV
- Contact Televisions Stations to show 'Proclamations'

#### Radio

PE schedules, Interviews, Press Releases

#### **Social Media**

Facebook, Internet Bulletin Boards, etc.





## Reporting

Each Unit is required to submit their NSBW Action
Plan to the District SPO-NSBW before May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015

Each Unit is required to submit an After-Action Report to the District SPO-NSBW by July 1st, 2015





## Reporting

Need to report successes up and down the chain

After all reports are received, a comprehensive report of the District efforts during NSBW will be prepared and shared with the DIRAUX and D5NR Senior Leadership

Final Comprehensive Report will be posted to D5NR Public Affairs Website





#### Flotilla Report

Normal reporting using Auxiliary Forms 7029, 7030, 7046, etc., will still be required. In addition:

- •How many VSCs were accomplished?
- •How many MDVs were accomplished?
- •How many students took Safe Boating classes taught by the Flotilla?
- •How many hours were spent on Public Affairs efforts (boat shows, school presentations, etc.)
- •What was the highlight of the Flotilla NSBW campaign?
- •How can the District PA team assist in future campaigns?

Please Notify ADSO-PA of any scheduled events

- •These will be put on the District Master PA Event

  Calendar
- Allows for better allocation of resources
- Reduces scheduling conflicts
